- Mallet
- Map of the area (physical copy)
- Compass or GPS device
- Portable phone charger (optional, but useful)
- Battery-powered radio (optional, for remote locations)

Safety and Emergency Gear:

- Whistle or Personal Locator Beacon (PLB)
- First-aid kit (well-stocked with bandages, antiseptic wipes, pain relievers, antihistamines, and any medications needed)
- Insect bite relief cream, sunscreen, and blister pads (optional)
